The grievance of the petitioner is that private respondents No.5 to 13 are forcibly trying to dispossess him from the common land, which has been in his possession since 1996 and the police is not taking any action to protect his possession despite representation dated 16.07.2018 (Annexure P-6). Even if it is taken that the petitioner is an unauthorized occupant, nobody can be dispossessed forcibly.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Let five copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. In view of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to private respondents No.5 to 13.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to

objectively consider the representation dated 16.07.2018 (Anneuxre P-6) and take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is found necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
