This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.135 dated 11.07.2015, under Sections 306, 506, 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No.7 (Vardhman) Ludhiana City, Ludhiana.

It is contended in the petition that the aforesaid FIR does not reflect any specific allegations against the accused persons and they have been falsely implicated in the present case.

Notice of motion was issued in the matter as far back as 16.11.2015 and the matter has been adjourned to subsequent occasions. On 27.01.2017, a short reply has been filed by way of affidavit of Saurav Jindal, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (East) Ludhiana, submitting that a cancellation report has been prepared, but the same is yet to be filed in

the court. Thereafter on 11.12.2017, the matter was again taken up, on which date learned counsel for the respondent-State had submitted that the cancellation report has been approved, but the same has not been filed.

Today, this court is informed that after approval, the cancellation report has been filed in the court and the same is pending for its acceptance since 14.12.2017.

In view of the fact that a cancellation report has been filed in the matter before the Illaqa Magistrate and the same is pending for its acceptance, this court is not inclined to interfere in the matter.

Disposed of, leaving it open to the petitioner herein to avail all remedies available to him in accordance with law and to have the instant petition revived, in case, the said cancellation report is not accepted, if he so desired.
