FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Sumit Kumar in case registered by way of FIR No.0280 dated 02.08.2017 at Police Station Sadar Jind under Sections 323, 34, 342, 506 IPC and Section 3(2)(VA) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 29.09.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ravinder Singh from Police Station Sadar Jind who submits that the petitioner is no longer required

for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

However, learned counsel for the complainant has sought to oppose grant of bail on the grounds that there is wrong averment made in the petition to the effect the petitioner was not named in the FIR.

Appreciating the submissions, keeping in view that the petitioner has joined investigations, his custodial interrogation is not necessary and thus, in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.09.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
