The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.63 dated 01.05.2017, registered under Sections 15, 16, 27-A of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (for short 'the Act') at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

Petitioner was facing trial for the offence under Section 18 of the Act for having in possession of 25 kg of poppy husk which falls within non-commercial quantity. He was granted bail by the learned trial court but he could not appear on one date i.e. 31.07.2018, therefore, his bail was cancelled and bail bonds were forfeited to the State. Now he has surrendered before the trial court and released on interim bail.

In this view of the matter, the interim order dated 31.08.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
