Instant petition has been preferred under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. seeking cancellation of pre arrest bail granted to the private respondents herein vide order dated 13.07.2017 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur in case FIR No.03 dated 28.02.2017, under Sections 380, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station NRI Wing, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

During the course of hearing today, it stands conceded that the accused as also the complainant party are in litigation pertaining to agricultural land as also the residential premises in which the alleged theft is stated to have taken place.

Counsel has not been able to substantiate as regards the private respondents herein having misused the concession that was granted on 13.07.2017.

In this regard, counsel has made a reference to a

complaint having been made to the Inspector General of Police, Non-Resident Indian and Women Cell, Phase-VII, Mohali at Annexure P-3 to contend that after grant of anticipatory bail, an attempt has been made to threaten and to intimidate the complainant party.

The complaint has been perused. The same does not carry any date. Even the contents thereof and assertions contained therein are utterly vague.

No ground for cancellation of concession of anticipatory bail has been made out.

Petition dismissed.
