By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 so as to protect his life and liberty as he apprehends threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5. Respondent No.4 is son of the petitioner while respondent No.5 is daughter-in-law of the petitioner.

As per the averments made in the petition, the petitioner had transferred his house in the name of his son who further sold it and bought a new one. It is alleged that the petitioner was however thrown out of the house constraining him to approach the Court of learned SDM, Jalandhar under Senior Citizens Act, 2007 wherein vide order dated 13.11.2015, directions were issued to respondent No.4 to provide room, kitchen and passage in the house to the petitioner and not to alienate the same. Learned

counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner however apprehends threat to his life and liberty as respondents No.4 and 5 are pressurizing him to transfer all his assets including cash amount.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-1) expeditiously. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded, then necessary steps as warranted under law be taken thereupon immediately. Further in case it is found that there is any threat to life and liberty of the petitioner, then it be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioner.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-1 be sent to respondent No.2 immediately so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
