This is a petition for quashing of FIR registered for offences under Sections 279 and 304-A and the subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise, during pendency of the appeal. Realizing that this cannot be done at the stage of appeal, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition and he would apprise the Appellate Court with regard to the compromise praying for taking of lenient view on the point of sentence.

The present petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn, with the observation that the Appellate Court may take into consideration the fact of matter having been compromised between the parties, while considering the point of quantum of sentence.
