In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 of Cr.P.C in case FIR No.529 dated 15.07.2018 registered under Sections 408, 420, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Gurugram, District Gurugram.

2. Petitioners were granted the benefit of interim bail vide order dated 31.8.2018 and directed to join investigation. In the event of his arrest, investigating/arresting officer was directed to release him on interim bail on his furnishing bonds.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Manoj Kumar submitted that pursuant to the order dated 31.8.2018, petitioner is stated to have joined the investigation. It is further submitted that to some extent petitioner is not co-operating with the investigation insofar as revealing certain things. Otherwise he has appeared before the Investigating Officer.

4. Petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation once again if the investigating officer calls for the petitioner and he is hereby directed to co-operate in the matter.

4. Accordingly, order dated 31.8.2018 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under

Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petitioner is directed not to indulge in any criminal activity or to interfere with the fair trial.

6. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
