Petitioners Avtar Singh and Sabbu Singh @ Dharminder Singh have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest in FIR No.73 dated 09.08.2018 under Sections 295-A, 323, 506, 511, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 04.09.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh, states that though the petitioners have joined the investigation, but the motorcycle is yet to be recovered.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and the parties are already in civil litigation, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 04.09.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
