The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.192 dated 24.09.2015 registered for offences punishable under Sections 485/486/420/120-B of Indian Penal Code; 103/104 of Trade Marks Act, 1999 and 63/64 of Copyright Act, 1957, at Police Station Division no. 7, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that costs as per order dated 04.09.2018 has been deposited and the petitioner has also appeared before the trial Court and has been allowed interim bail. The next date fixed for consideration on framing of charge is 13.11.2018.

Keeping in view the fact that petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been allowed interim bail, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and order dated 04.09.2018 is made absolute, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall keep on appearing before trial Court regularly;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court;
