ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. :

This is a second petition for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.82 dated 13.06.2018 under Sections 326,325,323,506,148,149 IPC registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur. The first petition i.e. CRM-M No.33215 of 2018 was dismissed as withdrawn on 10.08.2018 qua the petitioner.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner Gurmukh Singh was armed with a gandasi and had given a blow to the complainant/injured Amrik Singh on his right knee and thus injury No.4 which is incised wound was declared grievous.

No ground for anticipatory bail is made out as the grievous injury under Section 326 IPC is attributed to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed.
