Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that other than the fact that the complainant is also a man of dubious character having also been convicted with many other FIRs registered against him, there were injuries inflicted on the side of the petitioners also, but no cross-case was registered by the police.

Without making any comment on the merits of the aforesaid contention, seeing that the challan has already been presented and there is no other criminal case stated to have been registered against the petitioners even as per the learned State counsel, who says so on instructions to that effect, I consider it appropriate to admit all the petitioners to bail, on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
