In the instant petition, petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.503 dated 01.10.2012 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Ballabhgarh City, District Faridabad and consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that present FIR is an outcome of sudden quarrel between the parties and in fit of anger. Now the matter has been resolved and sought for quashing of FIR in view of compromise.

3. This Court vide order dated 04.09.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad, has sent his report dated 05.10.2018

wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded and compromise appears to be genuine.

4. In view of the law laid down in “*Anita Maria Dias and another versus State of Maharashtra and another*” (2018) 3 SCC 290, no useful purpose would be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.503 dated 01.10.2012 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Ballabhgarh City, District Faridabad and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners subject to payment of litigation cost of Rs.5000/- by each of the petitioners to State of Haryana. Cost shall be remitted in the District Treasury, District Faridabad, State of Haryana within a period of 3 months from today.
