In this petition, petitioner has sought for quashing of FIR No.31 dated 11.02.2014 under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar, Tehsil, and District Amritsa and consequential proceedings i.e. Report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. dated 05.02.2016 and charge-sheet dated 07.07.2018.

2.) Petitioner has not apprised this Court as to how he is not involved in the transaction between the complainant and the petitioner and others in respect of purchase of vehicle and duping the complainant. Once the respondents-police have taken action wherein petitioner's name is cropped up, question of interference with the FIR do not arise as charges against the petitioner has already been framed and he has remedy of revision against the framing of charge. Moreover, scope of interference in respect of quashing FIR under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is very limited. Thus, petitioner has not made out a case.

3.) Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
