The petitioner prays for issuance of directions to official respondents to take legal action against the private respondents, who are allegedly intimidating and threatening the petitioner.

It is alleged by the petitioner that the private respondents induced the petitioner to purchase some property, which was under the legal bar. The petitioner's earnest money is also not being returned. A detailed representation dated 27.03.2018 (Annexure P-1) has been submitted in this regard but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. J.S. Walia, Sr. DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to respondents No. 4 and 5.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 27.03.2018 (Annexure P-1) and to

take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
