Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.122 dated 19.09.2017 under Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has again joined the investigation and handed over the tractor and arrow to the Investigating Officer and later on, the same has been released in favour of the petitioner by the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 06.10.2017 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
