Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail in the light of registration of FIR No.94 dated 04.07.2017, at Police Station Sadar Rewari, District Rewari, under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, against him.

Initially, the protection was granted to the petitioner but during the course of investigation, the petitioner although has got recovered the printer but has not got recovered the laptop, which was used for creating the fake cover notes/policies of the insurance. On the last date of hearing, this very question was raised by the counsel for the State, on instructions, as

during investigation, petitioner has stated that he had sold the laptop but he has not disclosed the details as to where and to whom the said laptop has been sold. Today also, the position remains the same although counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner never possessed the laptop and in fact, the printer was also recovered on the pressure put by the police authorities.

Be that as it may, laptop is an essential gadget, which is required to be recovered, which could connect the petitioner with the commission of offence. It appears that the petitioner is taking the benefit of interim relief, which has been granted by this Court in his favour and is misusing the same by not cooperating with the investigating agency.

No ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out. The petition stands dismissed.
