The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.113 dated 27.07.2018, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

The FIR has been registered on the basis of secret information to the effect that the petitioner alongwith one Gursewak Singh used to bring the intoxicant powder and tablets and sell the same.

It has been submitted that recovery has been effected from the shop of co-accused Gursewak Singh.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jageer Singh, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case,

I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to

the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 04.09.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
