Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to safeguard the lives of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

Reply by way of affidavit of DSP, Sub Division, Barnala, on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. As per this reply, a detailed enquiry was conducted by DSP, Investigation, Barnala and during enquiry, statements of concerned persons were recorded and it was found that there is no apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.6, who is wife of petitioner No.2 and daughter-in-law of petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel representing respondents No. 5 and 6 has also stated that there is a matrimonial dispute between the parties with regard to mal-treatment given by the petitioners to respondent No.6.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered as infructuous.

However, it will be open for the parties to approach the competent Court of law for redressal of their grievance regarding matrimonial dispute.
