Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 87 dated 29.05.2017 under Sections 3 and 4 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The operative part of the order dated 04.09.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had noted a wrong date as 15.03.2018 instead of 15.01.2018 and thereafter, her bail/surety bonds were cancelled and non bailable warrants were issued. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner was granted regular bail by the trial Court and she was attending the Court. However, on account of noting the wrong date, she was absented from the proceedings. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court and apply for fresh bail.

Notice of motion for 25.09.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 04.09.2018, has already appeared before the trial Court and she has been released on interim bail on furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds and payment of cost of Rs. 5,000/- as directed by this Court.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has joined the Court proceedings.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 04.09.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
