ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. :

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.20 dated 23.02.2017 under Sections 452,323, 324,325,506,148,149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sunam, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, which was registered on the statement of one Anil Kumar, the petitioner, along with other co-accused entered his house and gave beatings to him as well as to his father. A perusal of the FIR further shows that the petitioner has caused injury on the head of the father of the complainant namely Kundan Lal with gandasa, which hit on the right side of his forehead. A perusal of the FIR further shows that the petitioner is also attributed one gandasa blow on the head of the complainant.

Since, there are serious allegations of causing repeated injuries on the head of the father of the complainant as well as on the complainant himself, that too while entering in the house of the complainant, I find, no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed.
