Challenge in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. was to the order dated 17.07.2013, passed by the trial Court whereby, petitioner was declared proclaimed person in FIR No.76 dated 04.05.2010, under Sections 307, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act (challan presented under Sections 336, 148 & 149 IPC), registered at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that in a connected matter i.e. CRM-M-37362 of 2017, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has joined trial proceedings in pursuance to order dated 07.10.2017, passed by this Court and the concession of anticipatory bail has been

affirmed.

Under such circumstances, the instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
