Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.283 dated 14.06.2018 under Section 379-A IPC, registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the complainant has made an allegation that a lady has snatched her bag while she (complainant) was travelling in a three-wheeler and when the complainant alighted, her two companion ladies pushed her and in this manner, the petitioners managed to fled away. The bag of the complainant contains ₹3,000/- and a driving licence. He further states that the petitioners are in custody since 14.06.2018 and even petitioner No.3-Sharda has delivered a baby in jail and the trial in this case will take a long time.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel on instructions from HC Balwant Singh states that though the challan has been presented and the petitioners are of different State, therefore, it cannot be said that they are falsely implicated in this case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that challan has been presented, trial in the case will take sufficient long time and the petitioners are in custody since 14.06.2018, I deem it appropriate to release them on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of their bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

Since the petitioners are residents of Maharashtra, the trial Court may put any other condition as may deem fit in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case.
