The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.10 dated 26.07.2018, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women, District SAS Nagar Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein submits that the matter has been settled before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court vide Settlement/Agreement dated 26.09.2018 and pursuant to the compromise, a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has already been filed, which fact is not disputed by learned State counsel.

In view of the fact that the matter stands compromised between the parties, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the

petition is allowed and order dated 04.09.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
