The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.278 dated 25.10.2017, registered at Police Station Barauda, District Sonipat, under Sections 364-A, 506 and 34 IPC.

The contents of the FIR reveals that main accused, namely, Ashok allegedly kidnapped the complainant and made him sign some papers under threat. He also demanded Rs.33,00,000/- from the complainant and threatened if the amount was not given he and his grand-son would be killed. The petitioner is alleged to have accompanied the main accused-Ashok.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 07.05.2018. Investigation in this case is complete and the main accused, namely, Ashok has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 13.07.2018, passed in CRM-M-25944-2018. Thus, the petitioner be also granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel is not able to dispute the aforementioned factual submission.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner-Anil, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
