In this petition under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C, petitioner has sought for regular bail in case FIR No.51 dated 05.06.2018 under Sections 420/465/467/468/471 IPC, registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka (Annexure P-1). Petitioner has been arrested on 05.06.2018.

2.) Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner's role in the alleged incident is limited to the extent of showing particular property to the complainant for the purpose of sale transaction and petitioner's name has been shown in one of the alleged to be forged *jamabandi*. It is submitted that challan has been filed. The aforesaid facts have not been disputed by the learned State counsel. Since Trial Court

proceedings would take some more time and the fact that petitioner is aged about 70 years, petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

3.) Heard.

4.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Chan Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the entire satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned with the following condition:-

Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.
