SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioners, who are the accused persons in F.I.R No.0029, dated 25th January, 2017, under Sections 307, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula (Annexure P-1), have prayed for quashing of F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

2. Ms. Kuldeep Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4 and filed his Power of Attorney today in the Court; Be kept on record.

3. The complainant and injured/victims have now arrived at a settlement with the accused persons vide Compromise Deed (Annexure P-3), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to

genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The Ld. District and Sessions Judge, Panchkula vide report dated 30th November, 2017 has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

4. Respondents No. 2 to 4 are represented by their counsel and do not dispute the factum of compromise.

5. In view of the report of the Ld. District and Sessions Judge, Panchkula, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **“Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **“Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466**, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the complainant has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioners/accused persons.

6. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. F.I.R No.0029, dated 25th January, 2017, under Sections 307, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed *qua* the present petitioners.
