ANITA CHAUDHRY, J (ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 66 dated 11.11.2016, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, Police Station Women Cell, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 6.2.2017, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that they have returned all the articles.

There is a dispute with respect to return of the gold items. The complainant can raise the dispute before the trial Court.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 6.2.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
