The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0752 dated 29.09.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 120-B, 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station Hisar Civil Lines, District Hisar, Haryana.

Heard.

It is a case of prosecution that in fact co-accused Raj Verma and Sukhdev Malhotra were found duping the people and collecting money. Only mobile phone has been recovered from the petitioner. His liability qua offences under Sections 120-B, 406 and 420 is debatable. He is in custody since 23.10.2017. A final report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C has been submitted to the court and trial has been initiated. Nothing is to be recovered from him.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Jatin son of Lal Sahai is

ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court / Chief Judicial Magistrate / Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) *The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.*
- (b) *In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.*
- (c) *He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.*
