The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.134, dated 31.05.2017, registered under Section 21-C of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short 'NDPS Act') at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

[2]. It is submitted by Ld. State counsel that even though challan has been sent up, but charges have not yet been framed since the Chemical Analysis Report is still not available. In the meantime, the petitioner has remained in detention for more than nine months since his arrest on 30.05.2017.

[3]. There is no record of his involvement in any other case under the NDPS Act, on account of which, his further detention for indefinite period is not justified.

[4]. As such, the interim bail granted to the petitioner earlier is, therefore, confirmed.
