Petitioner Ved Parkash has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.1449 dated 26.12.2017, registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad, under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The allegation against the present petitioner is that he had produced fake driving licence in the MACT proceeding. He had handed over one driving licence to the police having issuance and expiry date different than the licence produced before the Court.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 05.09.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not

required for custodial interrogation. The case is based upon documentary evidence. Nothing is to be recovered from him. No useful purpose would be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 05.09.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
