In the present petition, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.191 dated 30.07.2018 under Sections 307, 323, 341, 336, 337, 160, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC and 25,27,54 of Arms Act 1959, registered at Police Station Division No.6, Distt. Jalandhar.

Anticipatory bail application in respect of co-accused Arshpal Singh Sandhu and other co-accused have been considered by this court. Having regard to the group clash read with firing of gun shot which results in trauma amongst the general public as the alleged incident occurred in general public place, petitioner has not made out a case on par with Arshpal Singh Sandhu and Sahil Arora. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
