1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner, prayer has been made for issuance of directions to official respondents to investigate FIR No.119, dated 23.06.2006, registered under Sections 420/506 IPC, at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar and to arrest the accused persons i.e. respondents No.7 and 8.
