Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Tejvir Singh, Police Station Women, Bathinda, District Bathinda submits that in consequence of interim order dated 05.09.2018, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and he does not oppose the grounds of bail.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.09.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
