The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in case FIR No.46 dated 29.07.2017 registered at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot, under Section 307 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been in custody since 30.7.2017 and that the investigation is complete. Moreover, the parties have compromised the matter and, therefore, the petitioner is entitled to be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel submits that three persons have sustained injuries due to the firing of the weapon by the petitioner. He, however, does not dispute the fact that the investigation is complete.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant affirms the fact

that the parties have reached the compromise and that quashing of the FIR has also been sought by way of separate petition.

Keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances of this case, it would be just and expedient to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
