Petitioner Amit has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.215 dated 12.12.2017, registered at Police Station Bond Kalan, District Charkhi Dadri, under Sections 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code (however in challan, Sections 468, 471, 120-B and 34 of IPC were also added).

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegation in the FIR, Sunil is the main accused, who had taken Rs.4,50,000/- from the complainant for providing appointment to his son in Army. The present

petitioner has not been named in the FIR. He has been nominated on the disclosure statement of main accused.

The challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody since 21.05.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
