The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 75 dated 24.05.2018, registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC, Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner urges that the petitioner was married to the deceased 12 years ago and she was living in the matrimonial home since February 2018 and a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act had been filed by the husband and the next date was 03.08.2018. Counsel says that the challan has been presented and the trial will take time.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
