ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.47 dated 11.05.2018, registered under Sections 306 & 120-B IPC Act at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that son of the petitioner was married to Banti Kaur and her death took place after 7 years of the marriage in the parents house. Though the allegations are that they had administered some poison but the parents of the girl took her home from the hospital and she died 4 days later.

A perusal of the FIR shows that the main allegations are that the in-laws family used to taunt the girl for not having a child and she was turned out of the house. The allegations are that the daughter had consumed poison on account of the taunts given by the family. FIR also refers to the

fact that the in-laws family had admitted her in Sarangdev Private Hospital where after first aid, they took her home. Police could not collect any material from the hospital.

Considering the allegations and keeping the fact in view that challan has been presented, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
