Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.72 dated 28.05.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 05.09.2018 of this Court, which was passed in the light of order dated 07.08.2018 passed in CRM-M-33797-2018 *Randhir Singh Vs. State of Punjab*, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that the custody of the petitioner is no more required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and her custody is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 05.09.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
