In view of the nature of order that is being passed there is no necessity to issue notice to private respondents No. 4 to 7 at this stage.

The petitioner has already made a representation dated 27.10.2017 (Annexure P-4) *inter alia* to respondent No. 2.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No. 2 to look into the representation (Annexure P-4) and make appropriate enquiry. He is also directed to take appropriate action in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
