The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 338 dated 07.08.2018, registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

The operative part of the order dated 06.09.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that vide pronote dated 04.12.2015, the petitioner had obtained a loan from the complainant to the tune of Rs.1.50 lacs and as per the FIR itself, the petitioner has returned the amount of Rs.1.30 lacs and the FIR has been registered by concealing the said fact. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to settle the dispute with the complainant.

Notice of motion for 26.10.2018. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 06.09.2018, has already appeared before the

SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Chamkaur Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 06.09.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
