The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. with a prayer to direct the respondents to conclude the investigation in case FIR No. 42 dated 22.03.2016, registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 506, 307, 324, 323 and 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda.

Upon notice, reply has been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2 by way of affidavit of Mr. Jaswinder Singh Chahal, PPS, DSP, Phul, Bathinda. In the reply, it is submitted that after investigation, a challan has been presented on 06.04.2017 in the present case against the accused persons under Sections 406, 498-A, 506, 307, 324, 323 and 120-B of the IPC.
