As already recorded in the order of this Court dated 18.01.2018, as per the report of the learned Additional Civil Judge (Sr.Div.)-cum-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khanna, the statements of the petitioners as also respondent no.2, i.e. the complainant in the FIR (Harpal Kaur), were recorded before that Court, to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with each other as regards the dispute in question, arising out of FIR no.262 dated 02.09.2015, registered at Police Station City Khanna, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 420 IPC (with Section 120-B IPC added later).

However the matter had still been adjourned, for learned State counsel to determine as to whether any other criminal case of like nature is registered against the petitioners or not.

from ASI Gurcharan Singh, submits that no other criminal cases are registered against the petitioners.

That being so and the matter having been compromised between the parties of their own free will even as per the assessment of learned SDJM as per her report, I see no reason to continue with criminal proceedings.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and FIR No.262, dated 02.09.2015, registered against the petitioners at Police Station City Khanna, Police District Khanna, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Section 420 IPC (with Section 120-B IPC added later), along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
