Present petition has been filed for seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.131 dated 27.06.2018 for the offences punishable under Sections 420/406/34 IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Trafficking Act, 2008 as well as DDR No.37 dated 29.06.2018, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. She has been roped in this case on the basis of disclosure statement of the husband of the petitioner. Disclosure statement is not admissible in evidence.

However, this Court does not find any substance in the argument raised by learned counsel for the petitioner. This has come in the statement of the husband of the petitioner that the petitioner is deeply involved in the business of sending people abroad.

In view of the above, this Court finds no ground to scuttle the

proper investigation by the police, by granting the anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Therefore, the present petition is dismissed.
