Petitioner is seeking anticipatory in case FIR No.93 dated 09.07.2018 registered under Sections 306 & 34 IPC at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the mother-in-law of the petitioner had committed suicide and an anticipatory bail had been allowed to Narinder Singh and Nirmaljit Kaur vide Annexure P-2 and the allegation is that the petitioner had demanded Rs.70,000/-. Counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no instigation or abetment.

Learned State counsel urges that the complainant had been married only 5 months ago and there was demand of dowry. The girl was

beaten up. She returned home after 1 ½ months and the petitioner used to make calls and was threatening the mother and was demanding Rs.70,000 as he wanted to go abroad.

Considering the allegations, no case for anticipatory bail is made out. The petition is dismissed.
