Prayer in the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.698, dated 08.07.2018, registered under Sections 147/148/149/323/379-B/452/506 IPC, at Police Station Ballabgarh City, District Faridabad.

According to the prosecution, in the evening of 05.07.2018, the petitioner and his five accomplices having iron rods in their hands gheraoed the complainant and caused injuries to him with their respective weapons. The petitioner also snatched golden chain from the neck of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the impugned FIR is a counter blast to the FIR lodged by the mother of the petitioner against brother of the complainant around four months back. The petitioner has falsely been implicated as he was not present at the spot and had gone to some showroom in Delhi, which is situated around 25-30 kilometers from the alleged place of occurrence.

Having given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds no merit in the instant petition in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation and recovery of iron rod, which he allegedly used in the commission of crime.

Dismissed.
