ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking anticipatory in case FIR No.145 dated 06.08.2018 registered under Sections 294/506/509 IPC at Police Station Behal, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations are that someone had called the complainant from a number and had hurled abuses and was threatening her and the mobile number is not his.

Learned State counsel informs that the call had been recorded and the phone number was taken on fake papers and are in the name of Krishan resident of Rajasthan and the police had contacted him and had found that the photo which was pasted on the form was not of that person and the call records were taken out of the number indicated in the FIR and it

was found that the person, who is using the phone was contacting one more person and therefore, the police contacted the other person and it was he, who informed that the caller was the petitioner. State counsel further submits that the petitioner was insisting upon marrying the daughter of the complainant and that is why he had made the threatening calls and now they have added Sections 420, 465 and 471 IPC.

Custodial interrogation would be necessary, recovery of phone is to be made.

No case for anticipatory bail is made out. The petition is dismissed.
