Present petition, which is the second one for the same purpose, has been filed for seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0194 dated 11.04.2018 for the offences punishable under Sections 406/420/506 IPC registered at Police Station Pehowa, Kurukshetra, Haryana.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that since, after dismissal of the first application of the petitioner, notice has been issued in the anticipatory bail application filed by the co-accused, therefore, the second petition by the present petitioner be also entertained.

This Court finds that the first anticipatory bail application of the petitioner has already been dismissed on merits. Therefore, it would not be appropriate to entertain the second application for anticipatory bail merely because notice is subsequently issued in the application of the other co-accused.

Dismissed.
