In this petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail in complaint case COMI/31/2013 in complaint No.42/2013 dated 05.04.2013 titled as Sarabdaman Singh Vs. Jaskaran Singh under Sections 420/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC.

2.) Initially petitioner had approached this Court and his petition was disposed of on 18.07.2018 while reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach appropriate forum for reconsideration of his bail. Thereafter, he has approached Sessions Court, Sri Muktsar Sahib and plea of the petitioner has been rejected on 23.08.2018 with the following observations:-

“Applicant has tried to plead that on account of illness, he could not surrender before the learned lower Court/Duty Magistrate within 15 days in terms of Order dated 10.10.2017. However, applicant has failed to plead in the application and also has failed

to produce any document in support of his above said assertions to show if he remained ill till 25.10.2017 or for more than 15 days thereafter as well because as per applicant, he fell ill on 14.11.2017. Obviously, applicant was having sufficient period of time to comply with the order dated 10.10.2017 but intentionally, he has not appeared. As such, there being no merit in the application, the same is dismissed. Record of learned lower Court be sent back and application file be consigned to the Record Room.”

3. Having regard to the conduct of the petitioner, he is not entitled to anticipatory bail. He has to surrender and make necessary application for regular bail.

4.) Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
