Prayer in the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.202, dated 09.08.2016, registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Sirsa Sadar, District Sirsa.

Briefly, the petitioner is facing trial in CIS No.NDPS-164 of 2016, pending before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sirsa and was appearing on each and every date. But due to some personal difficulty, the petitioner could not appear on 2.11.2017 before the trial Court. Consequently, the trial Court cancelled his bail and surety bonds and issued non-bailable warrants against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that intention of the petitioner on 02.11.2017 before the trial Court was not intentional or deliberate, rather was on account of some personal difficulty.

In view of the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, but without commenting on the merits thereof, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court within 10 days and move application for his bail, which shall be decided within two days.
